Re: Board Meeting – 5/21/2026, Presidents Report

First, a big thank you to our VP, Dwain Goforth for stepping in for me this month. Also to everyone who helped with the newsletter and on-air fund-a-thon. Chloe, I hope you're feeling better, I have been getting great feedback on our programming!

I put a couple of items on the agenda as noted below and I have an update on some follow-up I did on our Translator Project. Also, I am very happy to report that Deb Pollock, our bookkeeper has withdrawn her retirement/resignation plans. She's staying on!

- 1)** Re: Fairness in Political Programming: I added an item to the agenda concerning the equal time issue. A listener contacted me regarding the matter of one candidate having greater opportunity to promote their candidacy over their opposition. Since we have no Station Programmer running for elected office, I don't believe the equal time rule applies. However, we have discussed fairness during local elections and generally agreed our practices should reflect the tenants of the equal time rule.

I recommend that the Programming Committee develop policy guidance that reflects a spirit of fairness during elections.

- 2)** Radio PUSH policy: This issue has been brought up by Board member John Moorehead.

I recommend that the paid PUSH announcement practice be defined to be consistent with FCC guidelines.

- 3)** Translator Status: I had a very positive discussion with County Supervisor Helen Owen; we are meeting next week, on Monday, 5/25 in Middletown. We discussed briefly the idea of using the library. She has some other thoughts – including a couple of ranches with high elevation and the Coast Guard station, which now is under ownership of the Middletown Rancheria Pomo Tribal Government.

Another possibility I don't believe we've discussed is Rabbit Hill – owned by the Lake County Land Trust.

Anyway, a door of good will has been opened with the District Supervisor. I'll keep you all posted.
